WSU student makes money going ape

Bruce Hilliard of Pullman is putting himself through school at Washington State University. Hilliard the student spends most of his time studying, but when his telephone rings, Hilliard the entrepreneur businessman springs into action.

Half an hour later, an unsuspecting woman opens her front door and Hilliard the performer takes over.

Dressed as a gorilla and holding a colorful bouquet of balloons, Hilliard sings "happy birthday" to the almost always amused recipient of a singing telegram.

As the owner and star of "Delirious Deliveries," a singing telegram service, Hilliard has startled nearly 100 people all over Pullman, Moscow and Colfax since he opened business last October.

He and his fiancée, Kathy Bell of Pullman, who assists in the business, recently came off a busy weekend delivering musical valentines dressed as cupids: red leotards and tights, boxer shorts covered with red hearts, wings, and carrying bows and arrows.

Hilliard got into the singing telegram business as a way to earn money to pay his tuition bills at WSU, where he obtained a degree in music and is currently pursuing a public relations degree.

"Some friends of mine in Aberdeen

started doing it and they were pretty successful with it, so they helped me get started," Hilliard explained. "They gave me suggestions for what kinds of costumes were popular, and they had access to ordering them, so they set me up with the costumes. I would say the initial investment was over \$1,000, roughly."

Hilliard charges \$7 to deliver a small bouquet of balloons and a song, and \$11 for a larger bouquet. Twenty-one dollars will pay for a gorilla, showgirl, pig or other character to deliver the balloons along with an original song appropriate to the occasion.

Hilliard said that many prank-playing students have used his service, and sometimes parents will surprise a son or daughter with a singing ape on the doorstep.

Reactions to the deliveries are mixed.

"Most people just crack up laughing," Hilliard said. "Some people are really startled. It's not every day a gorilla shows up at your door. Now and then you get someone who's kind of shy. They try not to commit themselves too much. They just kind of sit back and let it all happen."

Hilliard's fiancée once delivered a birthday greeting to a student taking a final veterinary medical exam at WSU. Dressed in hot pants, a tux jacket and top hat, Bell walked into the auditorium, sang happy birthday to the nonplussed student, gave him a kiss and handed him the balloons.

"She had the whole class sing happy birthday to him," Hilliard recalled. "He was in between being embarrassed and eating it up."

The couple have done Christmas and children's parties, and have helped celebrate the birth of babies although, Hilliard commented, "a lot of times they don't like gorillas walking around the hospital."

Hilliard also delivers balloons dressed as Darth Vader, a pig, Richard Nixon and Santa Claus, but the most
